Star Trek Dream

Prayer call #87 – November 11, 2021

Monday, November 11, 2021, Donna brought Eric Metaxas to Wichita for an event. That night I had a dream that "our group" was helping with an event. The group had just taken communion and a woman (who in real life is a high level warrior-intercessor) came up and said that we all had on the wrong-colored shirts. We had on red shirts but needed to "change into the gold shirts". The shirts were like those worn by the crew in the original Star Trek series from the 1960's. Then the woman said, "We're not here to have fun; we're here to work!"

So, what is God saying in this?

"Our group" – We are made to be in community; We need the full complement of giftings in the Body of Christ to accomplish what God has for us to do. Unity in the Body of Christ is the crucial key in this hour. We must stick together!

The group took communion – We are in covenant with Jesus and with each other. Leviticus 26:8 says, "Five of you will chase a hundred and a hundred of you will chase 10,000, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you." That is a fivefold increase. God's math is multiplication, the principle of synergistic unity. One plus one is greater than 2 in the Kingdom. (I love God's math!)

The woman who told us that we were wearing the wrong-colored shirts was our leader in warfare; she was activating us to war!

Star Trek – Is an American science fiction media franchise which began in the 1960's. It has been expanded into various films, TV series, video games, and novels; estimated over \$10 billion in revenue. It is one of the most recognizable and highest grossing media franchises of all time. So, in the dream the Star Trek shirts were high-lighted.

The major setting for Star Trek is outer space. "Trek" is defined as: a long, arduous journey.

This speaks to me that we must war in the heavenlies. Ephesians 6:12 says, "for we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the

spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places." We are in a cosmic battle between Good and evil; it is not a cakewalk. We are on a trek – but take heart, God has promised to never leave us nor forsake us!

Red shirts and Gold shirts – The leader in the dream told the group that we needed to change out of our red-colored shirts and put on the gold-colored shirts.

One source I found said that in the original Star Trek series the crew members in engineering and security wore red shirts, while the gold/yellow shirts were reserved for command. It is a running joke among "Trekkies" that when there was a landing party on a mission, the unknown red-shirted crewman was doomed to be the one who died during that episode. We jokingly called him the "expendable crewman." That is no joke in the Kingdom – we are all INEXPENDABLE!

The Prophet's Dictionary says that **red** is the color of royalty and its duty to engage in war to defend its land and peoples; it is the color of sin and death and of warfare and its bloodshed. Since monarchies in the past were usually accomplished through warfare, the color of blood became the insignia of an ascending monarch's qualifying victories. **Gold** symbolizes the refinement of the spirits; royalty and transcendence; and is representative of the Spirit; opulent wealth and spiritual power.

This speaks to me of being dressed as Christians. We have spiritual armor to put on. We are bought, paid for, and covered in the red blood of Jesus. We are all part of the Body of Christ and qualified to be Kingdom fighters, not because of our own merit or accomplishments, but because of the warfare, bloodshed and victory of Jesus on the Cross. We belong to Him.

BUT – God is calling us to a higher level of authority and command. He is calling us to put on the gold shirt. He is activating us to higher levels of warfare and power in His Spirit.

In the final part of the dream the leader said, "We're not here to have fun, we're here to work!" There are many scriptures that instruct us on work.

Psalm 90 tells us that God establishes the work of our hands.

Romans 12 says to not be slothful but serve the Lord with zeal.

Provers 16 tells us to commit our work to the Lord and our plans will be established.

Philippians 4 says that we can do all things through Him who strengthens us.

Colossians 3 instructs us to work heartily, as for the Lord and not for man; from the Lord we receive our reward. We serve the Lord Christ!

Some Declarations:

We are unified by the blood of the Lamb and through Holy spirit living in us.

We hear our marching orders and are quick to respond. We take off the shirt of "simple" Christianity and put on the full armor of God's glory and take our positions to fight! This day we fight!

Our eyes are fixed on the author and perfector of our faith, YHWH Sabaoth – The Lord of Hosts – our Commander in Chief. We follow the Lord, in obedience, into His victory.

Overall, I sense God saying: **"Leave the security of "simple" salvation and advance in authority! You are commissioned for the mission!"**

Addendum: After the prayer call I found the newsletter from Destiny Ministries that I had not yet seen, for the Hebrew month of Kislev which corresponds to November 5 – December 4, 2021. The Subtitle on the newsletter states, "May you live long and prosper".

This immediately caught my attention! In the Star Trek franchise, the character Spock (portrayed by Leonard Nimoy, himself Jewish) would greet others with the Vulcan hand salute and phrase, "Live long and prosper". The Vulcan hand salute was created by Leonard Nimoy, himself. It is the physical representation of the Hebrew letter "shin," and comes from a Jewish prayer ceremony Nimoy remembered witnessing as a child. This confirms to me that the Star Trek dream is for now. God is amazing!!
