The Three Dreams

Prayer call 1/23/22

One night about 5-6 years ago, I had three short dreams that left me feeing unsettled. They were so strange and vivid that I mentioned them to my son the next morning, which happened to be a Sunday. During worship that morning Holy Spirit interpreted the dreams for me.

Dream #1: I was being attacked by a zombie that was trying to bite me. I kept trying to break its neck but just couldn't do it – it was too vicious!

Dream #2: I was lost in New York City and it was getting dark. I could not find my way back to where I was supposed to be – it was too dark to see where I was going. I tried going down several muddy alleys but couldn't find my way – I was hopelessly lost.

Dream #3: My family and I were swimming in a waterway A cruise ship was going by and making huge waves. We knew it was headed to the Caribbean/Bahamas and we wanted to go along. After frantically swimming after it we made a wrong turn and ended right back where we had started.

Interpretations:

#1: The zombie represented the flesh. Our flesh will kill us; it will eat you alive – you can't fight the flesh in your own strength – you are too weak. You can't fight the flesh with the flesh. You can only win through the supernatural power of Jesus Christ working in you through the power of Holy Spirit living inside you. Jesus overcame death, hell, and the grave. When we die to self is when we fully come alive. Galatians 5: 16-17 says when we walk by the Spirit we will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

#2: The descending darkness represented the occultic powers at work in our world. That is how the occult works – it engulfs us and surround us so that we get hopelessly lost in darkness. We cannot find our way. We must have the Light of the World to show us His way – He lights our path so that we can see the way to go – His path of righteousness. His way is right. Romans 16:20 says that Jesus, the

God of peace, has Satan under His feet. James 4:7 says to submit to Father, God, resist the devil, and he must flee!

#3: The cruise ship represented the world – it looks fun and glamorous, but as we chase after it, we will end up right where we started – looking for the next big ship to chase. We are left unsatisfied and wanting more. The world is unable to deliver what it promises – happiness, fulfillment, satisfaction. Only Jesus Christ delivers us out of the word's emptiness and brings us into His Kingdom of fullness and true satisfaction. In John 16:33 Jesus told us that in this world we will have trouble, but to take heart for He has overcome the world.

The scripture that comes to mind for these dreams is Psalms 27. I encourage you to look it up and declare it over your life, your family, and your territory.

Jesus wants our whole heart, not one that is divided up, part of it given to and taken over by the flesh, to darkness, or to the world. He intends for us to have life in Him and life abundant. YHWH made a way where there was no way, He is merciful and kind. May His truth, justice, righteousness, holiness rule and reign in our hearts! All to the glory of Jesus Christ!
